

Introduction to snorkelling (pool)

Can be tailored to suit students at upper primary, years 7-10 or 11-12

Location

Resort pool or Airlie Lagoon

Excursion Synopsis

Snorkelling safety is discussed and snorkelling skills are demonstrated and practiced.

Basic rescue techniques are demonstrated and practiced.

Students develop confidence in the water and develop safe snorkelling skills through a series of tasks and challenges.

In-water skills are developed to a level that enables students can view marine life without damaging it.

The sensory environment underwater is explored.

For Teachers

This activity is designed to prepare students for snorkelling safely and responsibly on a coral reef.

Students are instructed in basic snorkelling safety and skills and encouraged to practice and gain confidence in a shallow, protected environment.

Students develop a level of skills and control underwater to enable them to snorkel responsibly around corals.
